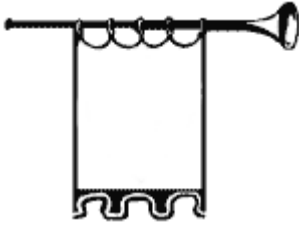
## **F**rom the Historian....

We are in need of volunteers for kitchen help at Defender. If you have any interest in cooking or serving, please contact me or Lady Caitriona as soon as possible.

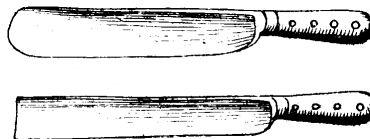
We need everything from simple taskers to accomplished cooks. If all you can do is serve, please respond also.

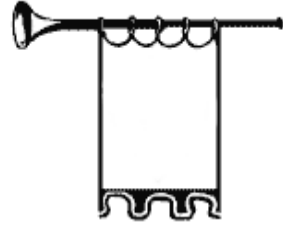

The time for Seawinds Defender draws nearer. If you are interested in helping out with any portion of the event, please let me know. I look forward to seeing you all at Defender.

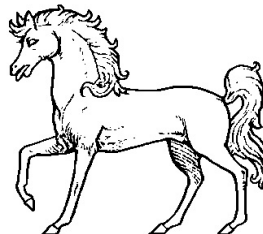

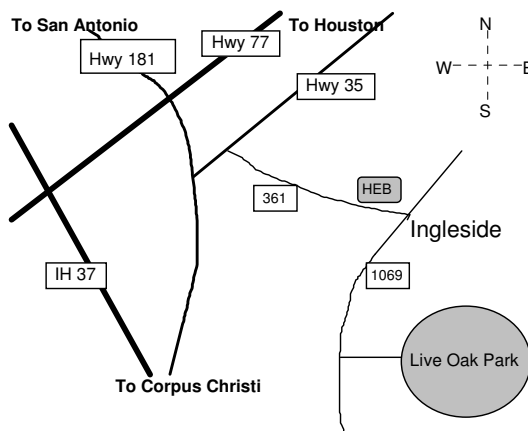
**Site** \$8 adults, \$6 children 6-17, 5 and under free; Family max \$24; \$3 non-member surcharge

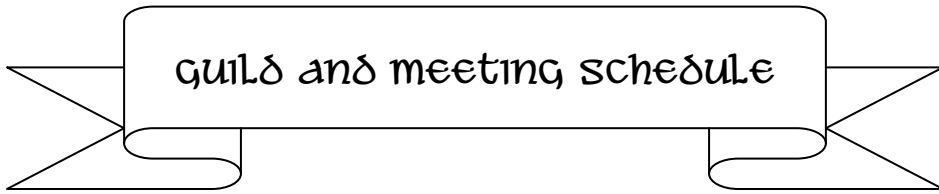
